Common signs of hearing loss:

- You often ask people to repeat themselves

- Voices sound muffled or unclear

- Phone calls are harder to understand
- You find yourself lip-reading without realising

The Science Behind the Sound

Modern hearing aids are advanced mini-computers designed to improve your hearing in real time. They work by picking up sound, processing it, and delivering it back to your ear in a way that matches your unique hearing needs.

How They Work (in 3 simple steps):

- 1. Microphone Detects sounds from your surroundings
- 2.Processor Customises and enhances the sound based on your hearing levels
- 3. Receiver/Speaker Delivers the optimised sound into your ear

This process happens instantly — helping you hear conversations more clearly, even in noisy environments.



How It Works

SMICROPHONES PICK UP SOUND

Tiny microphones on the hearing aid capture all sounds around you, from speech to background noise.

O2 PROCESSOR ENHANCES THE SOUND

The internal computer analyses the sound, reduces unwanted noise, and amplifies speech based on your hearing needs.

RECEIVER SENDS SOUND INTO YOUR EAR

A small speaker delivers the processed sound into your ear clearly and comfortably.

O4 YOUR BRAIN INTERPRETS THE SOUND

Your brain turns the sound into meaning — helping you follow conversations and feel connected again.



ADAPTING TO REAL LIFE

Most modern hearing aids also automatically adjust based on your environment — whether you're in a quiet room, a busy street, or a crowded restaurant.

Some even let you control settings with a smartphone app.

Types of Hearing Aids

Which One Is Right for You?

Behind-the-Ear (BTE) Sits comfortably behind the ear with a thin tube or mould that delivers sound into the ear. Easy to handle and very reliable.

Mild to severe hearing loss

Receiverin-Canal (RIC / RIE) A discreet style where the speaker sits inside the ear canal, connected to a slim wire. Popular for its sleek look and great sound quality.

Mild to moderate hearing loss

In-the-Ear (ITE) Fits fully inside the outer ear. Custommade and slightly larger than other inear options, making it easier to handle and adjust.

Mild to moderate hearing loss

Completely-in-Canal (CIC) / Invisible (IIC) Fits fully inside the outer ear. Custommade and slightly larger than other inear options, making it easier to handle and adjust.
